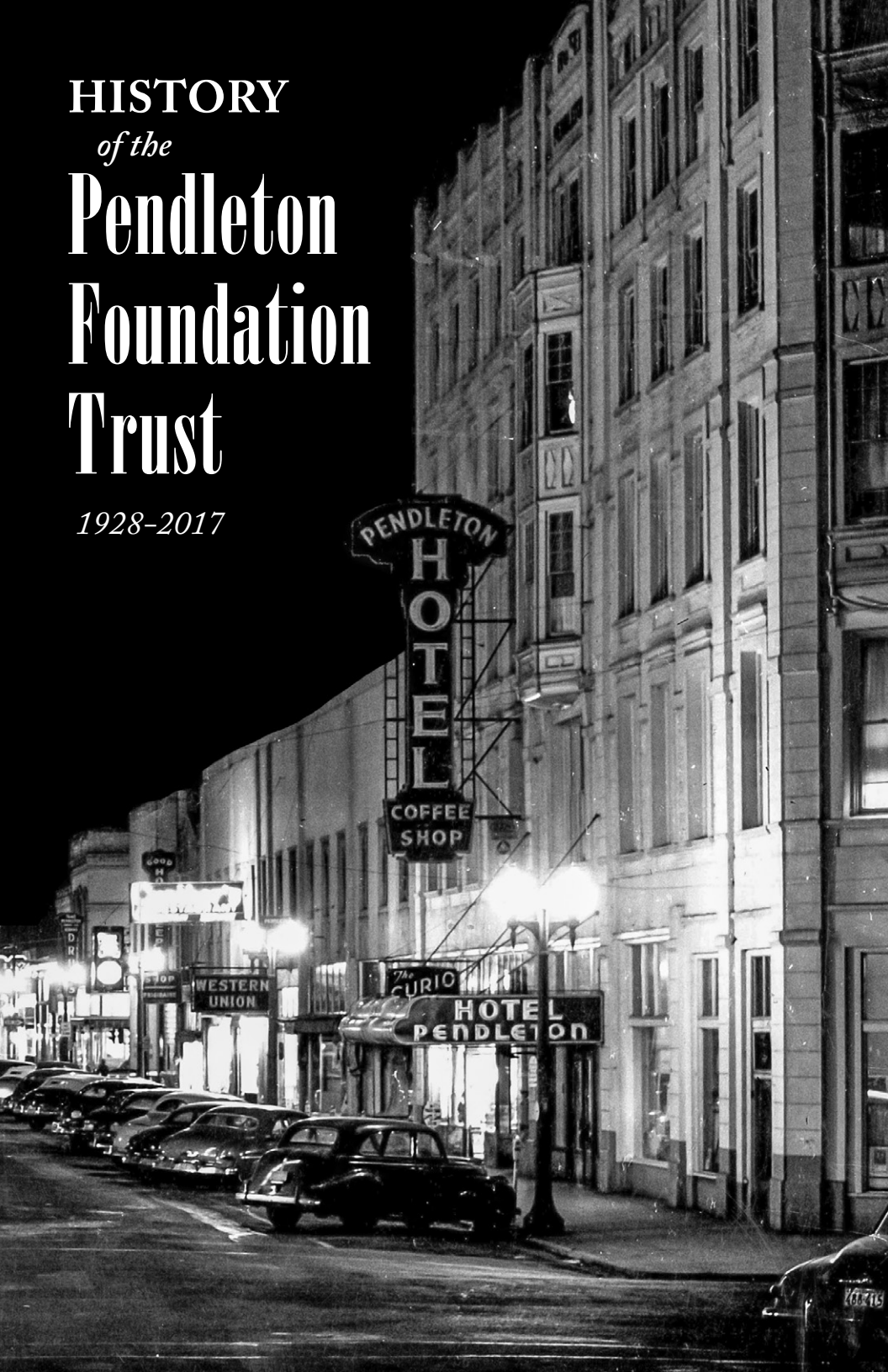

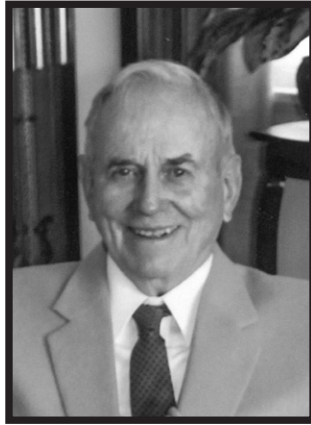

# The “*History of the Pendleton Foundation Trust, 1928-2017*” is one of the greatest stories.

It provides an example of excellence created by a citizenry totally committed to insuring the livability of the Pendleton area. It not only illustrates the importance of visionaries like its founders, but also is a tribute to those participating in PFT Board positions whom have carried on the development of the original goals.

In 1928 Pendleton was a burgeoning little town in Eastern Oregon. It was blessed with families who cared about the quality of life within. Resolute in purpose, they wished to insure the livability of the region. They possessed the foresight to insure quality of schools, community, and cultural needs, all of which would make the town truly pristine. And it did.

Col. James Raley was joined by other prime movers, and the first Trust Committee inaugurated its business. Raley was joined by James Akey, N. D. Swearingen and James S. Johns. R.M. Crommelin was appointed by the Commercial Association, The Mayor selected James A. Fee and the School Board appointed Mrs. E.W. McComas.

Adoption of the Resolution for the Trust became their guiding principal. This was stated as:

“To assist civic and educational undertakings whether now supported by private gifts or public taxation.

“To promote educational and scientific research.

“To improve living conditions or to provide recreation or recreational grounds for all classes.

“For such other civic or public purposes as will best make for the mental, moral and physical improvement of the inhabitants of the City of Pendleton, according to the discretion of the majority in number of a committee to be constituted as hereinafter provided and to be called and known as the Pendleton Foundation Committee.”

These lofty goals remain in place and continue as the Trust’s guiding principles.

Citizen participation continues today. Board members serve without reimbursement of any kind. Participation and longevity reign. The resignation of Dr. John G. McBee this year was accepted with genuine regret, as McBee had served 43 years. His influence will be remembered as a progressive factor in continuation of quality decisions made during his tenure. Other folks serving terms in excess of thirty years have been J. David Hamley (33 years), Dr. Jules F. Bittner (40 years), and E. Kenneth Jackson (33 years).

And the Pendleton Foundation Trust story continued to unfold. Over the course of its 89 year history, the Board has continued to earn respect in the community. Interest in financial contributions continued to grow. More and more grants to deserving projects promoted the original precepts. The Trust envisioned by the founders was being fulfilled.

Larger donations began to boost the earning power of the Trust as the years unfold. In 1992, the Jessie Furnish Estate gave a very generous bequest to the Pendleton Foundation Trust that totaled \$388,492.00. In 1996, the Mary Lecklider Estate gave a bequest of the proceeds from her home and her farm land to the Pendleton Foundation Trust that totaled \$266,180.00. In 1998 began the distribution of the residue of the Dan and Dorothy Bell Trust to the Pendleton Foundation Trust. When distribution was completed in 2004, the Pendleton Foundation Trust had received the sum of \$1,333,284.00 from the Dan and Dorothy Bell Trust, being the largest gift ever received from one entity. Another very generous gift was received in 2004 as a bequest from the John S. "Jiggs" Fisk Estate in the amount of \$460,693.00. In addition, the sum of \$115,173.00 was designated to establish the Jiggs and Maxine Fisk Memorial Scholarship Fund to provide scholarships to graduates of Pendleton High School. That was followed by another very large gift in 2011 from the David Horne Trust that totaled \$705,259.00. (earlier major gifts are defined in prior History books, which can be found on our website.)

The gifts received by the Pendleton Foundation Trust over the past 89 years, both large and small, have brought the total Trust funds to more than five million dollars strong as of 2017. The earnings from these monies continue to be granted to projects defined by the Founders and expedited by the present Board. May 10, 2018 will mark the 90th Anniversary of the Pendleton Foundation Trust. Over the past 89 years the foundation has given in excess of \$4,041,000.00 back to the Pendleton community.

The Association of Fund Raising Professionals, Oregon and SW Washington Chapter, presented the Distinguished Service Award to the Pendleton Foundation Trust as the Outstanding Philanthropic Foundation in 2011. The Board of Directors were honored to receive this award and special recognition.

But the final chapter of this story is not complete. And it won't be, because the needs will continue to grow, as well, as benefactors continue to donate to the cause. All are encouraged to join in this on-going effort by using bequests as memorials, gifts, or simply gifts to the community.
